

2019 CALL FOR NOMINATIONS
Board of Directors
Psychological Association of the Philippines

In September 2019, the terms of five current PAP Board Members will expire. **This is an official Call for Nominations to the PAP Board of Directors.**

Starting this year, we will begin implementing a provision in the amended PAP By-Laws, Article VII, Section 2 (please read Annex A attached to this call).

In September, 2019, therefore, we will be electing **six members to the Board of Directors**—the two with the highest number of votes (from any region) are designated Directors-at-Large; the four others will be the top voted from each of four geographic regions—NCR, Balance Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.

We are inviting PAP members to nominate candidates for the Board. We encourage you to nominate at minimum three from each region (in case the Directors-at-Large both come from the same region).

Qualifications of Board of Directors:

- 1) registered psychologists or psychometricians with at least 10 years of experience;
- 2) at least 3 years relevant supervisory experience;
- 3) one whose personal and professional conduct is beyond reproach; and
- 4) updated in membership dues.

Each must be willing to serve on the Board for the period September 2019 to September 2022.

Please note that in a vote during the March 18, 2019 BOD meeting, representation of each organization (i.e. university/college, company, etc.) is now limited to two board members serving at the same time. This practice was put in place to ensure that the board represents as many different organizations or institutions as possible. Please check with your nominee's organization/institution if they already meet this limit.

Any member of the PAP (Affiliate, Associate, or Fellow) may nominate a candidate. Self-nominations are also welcome. The nomination needs to be sent via email to: margaretalvarez@su.edu.ph and pap_1962_08@yahoo.com during the period starting **May 1, 2019 until July 31, 2019, 12:00 noon**. The subject line of the email should indicate **Nomination for PAP Board**.

All nominations should include the following:

1. Brief bio-data of the nominee in 100 words or less;
2. Statement of what the nominee plans to contribute to the PAP (e.g., PAP activities he/she plans to work on, new projects he/she will propose) in 100 words or less; and,
3. Recent photo of the nominee (head shot only please) in jpeg format.

Incomplete nomination materials will not be accepted. Bio-data and statements that go beyond 100 words will automatically be cut by the Committee on Elections after exactly 100 words.

Only **Associates, Fellows and Regular** members of the PAP who have paid their 2019-2020 membership dues are eligible to vote.

There are two approved ways of voting:

1. The eligible PAP member may cast his/her ballot during Days 1 & 2 of the PAP Convention in Davao (September 18-19, 2019). The ballots may be obtained from the PAP secretariat after confirming their membership status.
2. The eligible PAP member may vote online. Online votes from ineligible persons (upon confirmation by the PAP secretariat) will be discarded.

Online voting starts August 17, 2019 and ends September 17, 2019 at 3:00 pm. Actual voting will be from September 18, 10:30am to September 19, 3:00pm.

All nominee information will be published and posted on August 15, 2019.

The winning candidates will be announced during the Fellowship Dinner (September 19) of the PAP Convention. Nominees to the Board must be prepared to stay in Davao until the evening of Day 3 (September 20, 2019) because the new Board will have its organizational meeting during the post-convention workshops afternoon of Day 3.
